MINUTES OF THE LEAGUE MEETING HELD ON THE 21st of AUGUST AT THE HOUGH END CENTRE

1.0) GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

1a) <u>Role call</u>

2.0) LEAGUE OFFICERS REPORTS

2a) <u>Vice Chairman – Peter Walker</u>

- i) The Vice-Chairman explained that the Chairman had sent his apologies he was attending an FA meeting.
- ii) The Vice Chairman also welcomed everyone to the new season and gave a special welcome to the new clubs who have joined this season.
- iii) Although discipline was better last season, we still have a lot of work to do. We have the League Charter now so make sure your managers/coaches and spectators adhere to it.
- iv) The April MOM were accepted as a true record. Proposed by Mobberley and seconded by AFC Urmston Meadowside

2b) General Secretary - Andy Gorman

- i) The General Secretary advised that with so many teams sharing pitches especially from Under 12's and above the fixturing is a very complicated and interlinked process. Please check all the fixtures issued so far and advise if there are any issues. He asked that any permanent changes to venues or kick-off times only come via Club Secretaries we are getting requests from Managers to Divisional Secretaries that are do not fit with the Club's arrangements for their other Teams. Only changes from the Club Secretaries will be actioned.
- ii) ID badges: there are 1050 managers/coaches registered in WGS at the moment 930 badges have been processed, there are however, 120 outstanding from last season. The next "run off" will be on the 29th which will include anyone included as of the 26^{th of} August.
- iii) At the AGM we advised that we needed an Under 11 Divisional Secretary as 3 age groups were too many for Carla to handle. Lee Stewart was scheduled to be the League Welfare Officer; however, we did not receive any applications for the Under 11's Divisional Secretary role but instead Nick Wooldridge, currently Altrincham Juniors Club WO has agreed to be the LWO. This means that Lee can take the role of Under 11's Divisional Secretary.
- iv) There is a club Discipline Officers meeting arranged for the 11^{th of} September details will be sent out.
- v) To date 6,000 registrations have been received and ,5000 have been approved and a small number rejected. We estimate that in total we will get approximately 8,500 registrations.
- vi) Please make sure everyone in your Club is aware of and has seen the League Charter. Particularly important that Managers are familiar with it and take the lead in following it, to set the example to players and parents.
- vii) Please ensure managers are all familiar with the new rules on Fixture Free Weekends and on KO time changes.
 viii) Please make sure player suspensions that were served in 22/23 are cleared before the season starts County will need to do these for you otherwise the player ID sheet will show the player as suspended. iii) The Referees Secretary will try and appoint Referees up to Thursday evening – after that you can arrange your own – please advise Stuart if you acquire a Referee - as he will be still looking. If you don't advise him and he finds one, the League referee is to do the game.

- iii) We have had many issues of the last few seasons, with respect to, "failure to fulfil" because of insufficient numbers the League rules, 20 D) states the minimum number of players are as follows 5V5 = 4, 7V7 = 5, 9V9 = 6, 11V11 = 7. You must play if you have this number of players available.

2g) Assistant League Secretary John Halfpenny

- i) Last season teams from our league did exceptionally well in the Altrincham & District FA Sunday Cup, we had a quarter finalist and a semi-finalist I already have 11 applicants if anyone else is interested please contact me and I will provide the ADFA competition secretary with the details.
